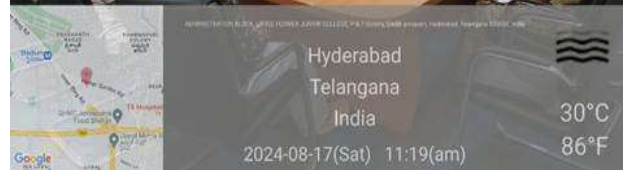

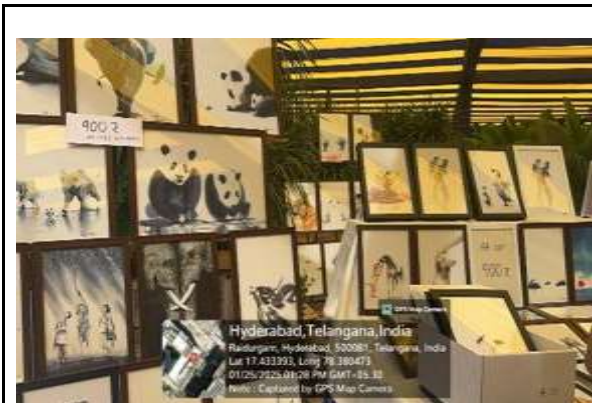

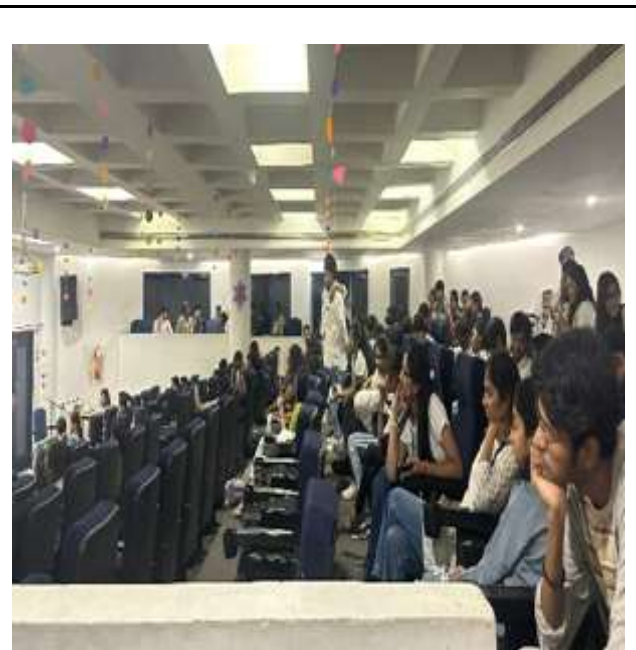
## MODERN LANGUAGE
