IQAC organized a Faculty Orientation Program on July 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> July 2023 to enhance faculty's understanding of fostering positive relationships with students and increasing self-awareness in teaching practices. On the first day, Dr. G. Padmaja, Associate Professor and Head, the Centre for Health Psychology School of Medical Science, University of Hyderabad, explained 'teacher-student relationship' in two sessions, actively engaging the faculty. Ma'am explained 'Transactional Analysis, a psychoanalytic theory used for determining the ego state (parent-like, childlike, or adult-like) as a basis for understanding behavior. And to help improve and develop self-awareness. Dr. Padmaja expounded on the Johari Window Model, which would aid in understanding relationships with ourselves and others. On the second day, Dr. B. Hymavathi, a psychological counsellor at the University of Hyderabad, explained in her session on "Mentoring" that it is a skill that has to be acquired. She discussed elaborately on how one can become successful in the art of mentoring. In the second session on "stress management", Mr. M. Subhash, Psychological counsellor, University of Hyderabad, explained the causes for stress, long term effects of stress and discussed different approaches that could be adapted to manage stress. Sessions were lively, interactive, and practical strategies were discussed, which led to an insightful learning.

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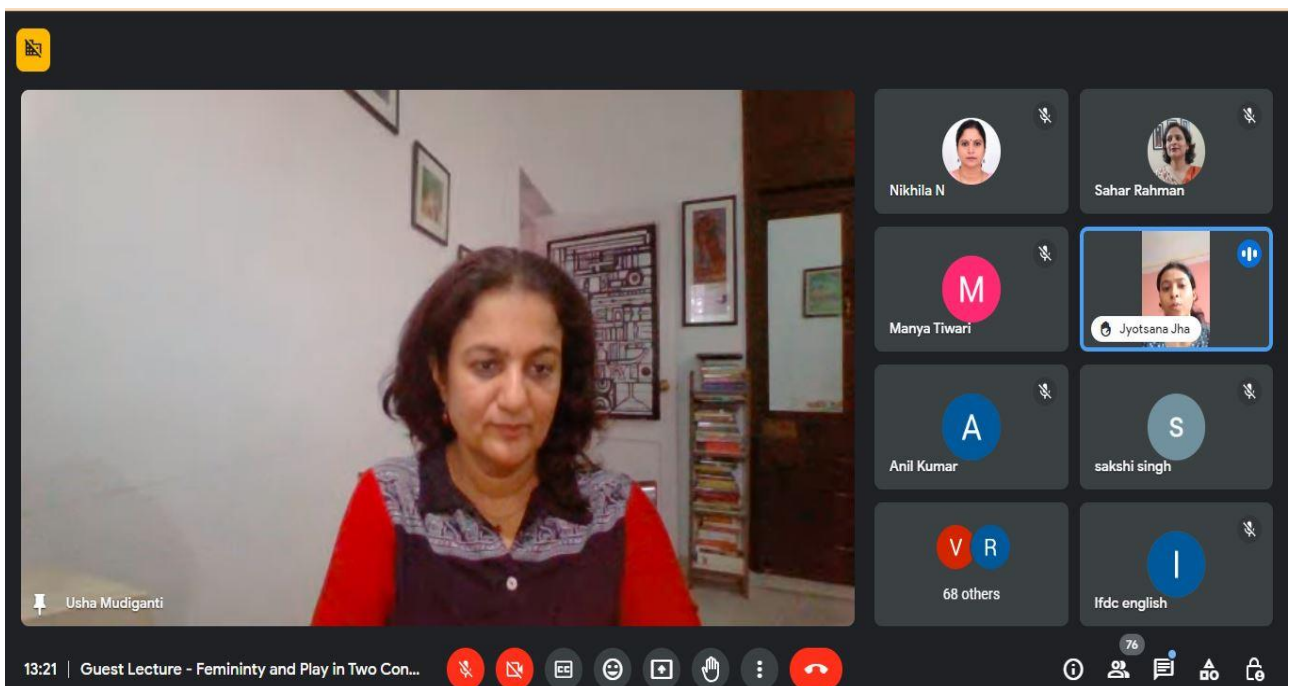

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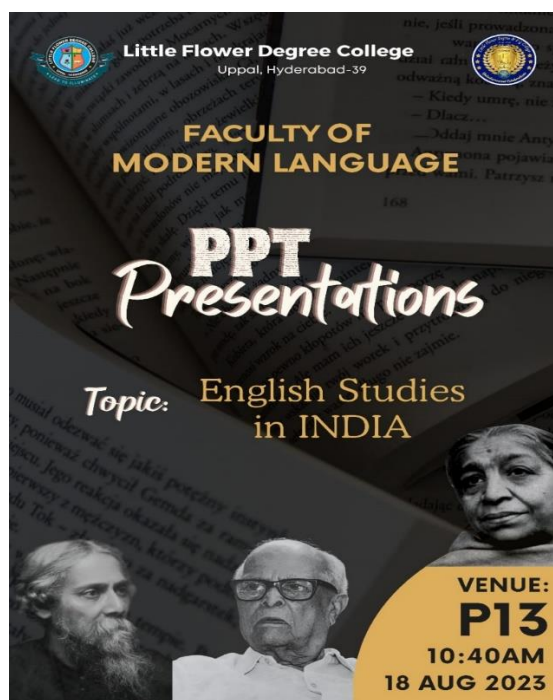
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### 5. CONDUCTED: ENGLISH STUDIES IN INDIA – PPT PRESENTATIONS

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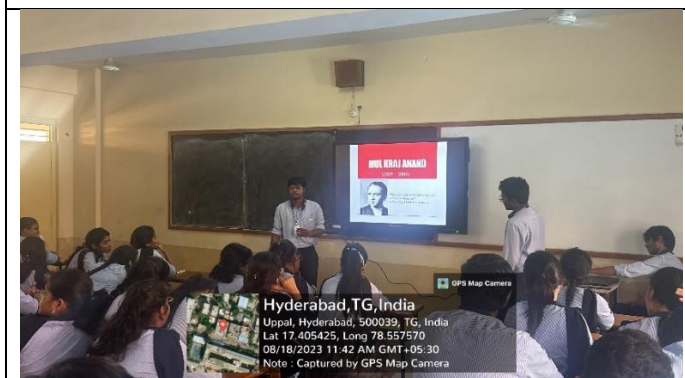

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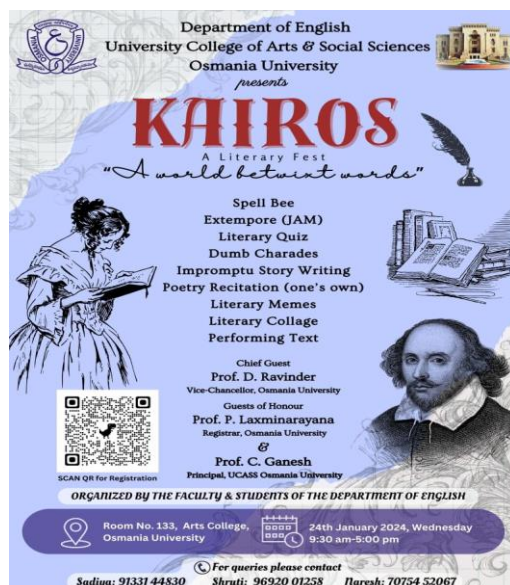
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### 10. ATTENDED: 'KAIROS' LITERARY FEST

On the last day, he provided a session on comprehensive choices in the Mendeley program and he assigned an assignment to make a PDF or MS Word file in which to compose one Abstract and Literature Review by utilizing Mendeley software reference. Participants had several queries and he clarified them. At the end of each session a test was conducted on the topics discussed.

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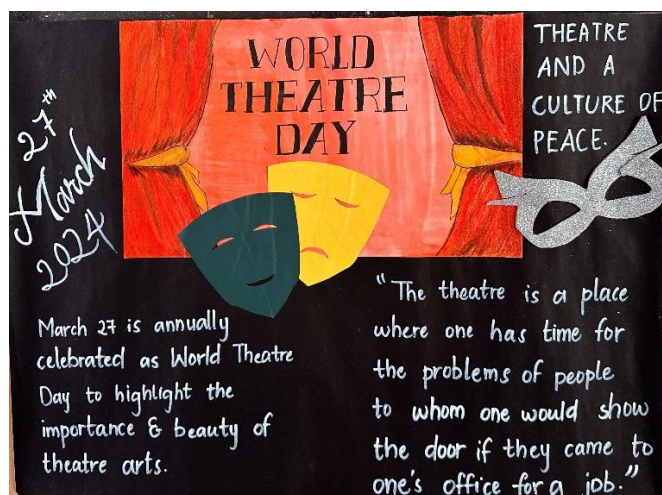
