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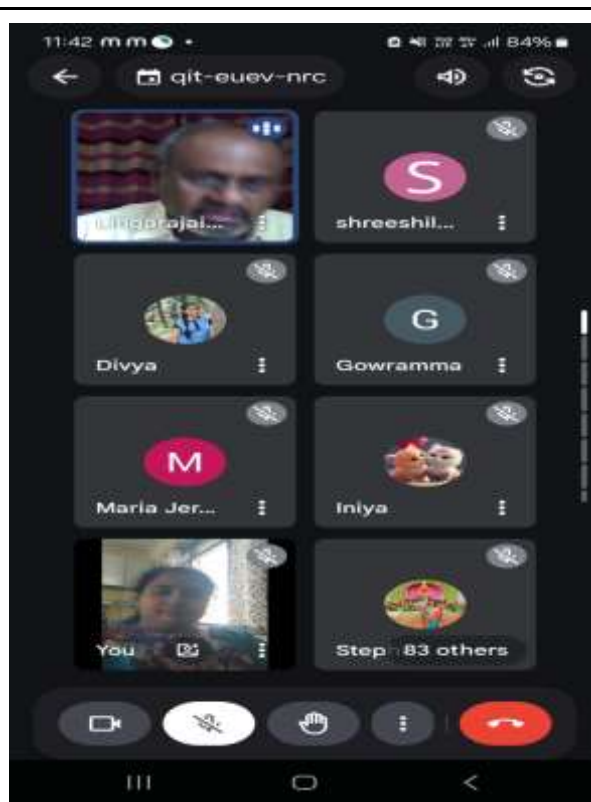
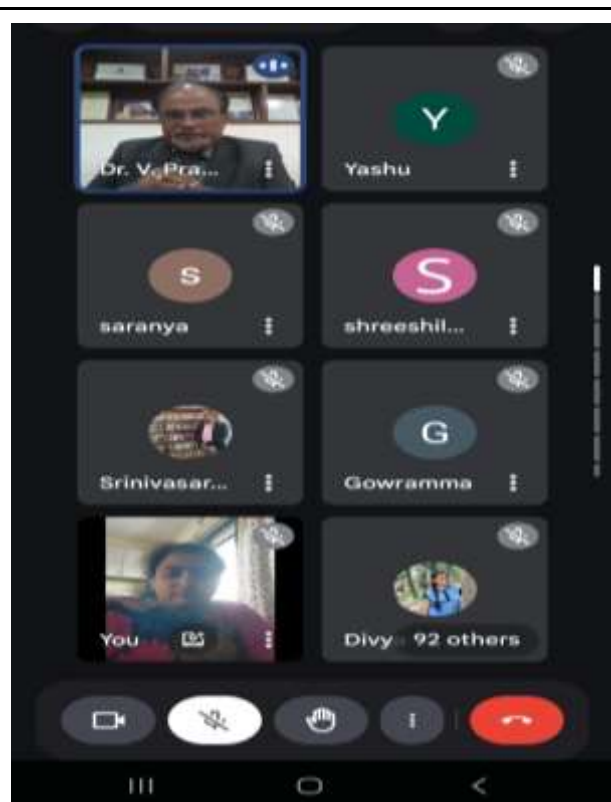
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1-Day Online National Webinar on Critical Thinking in Research Methodology

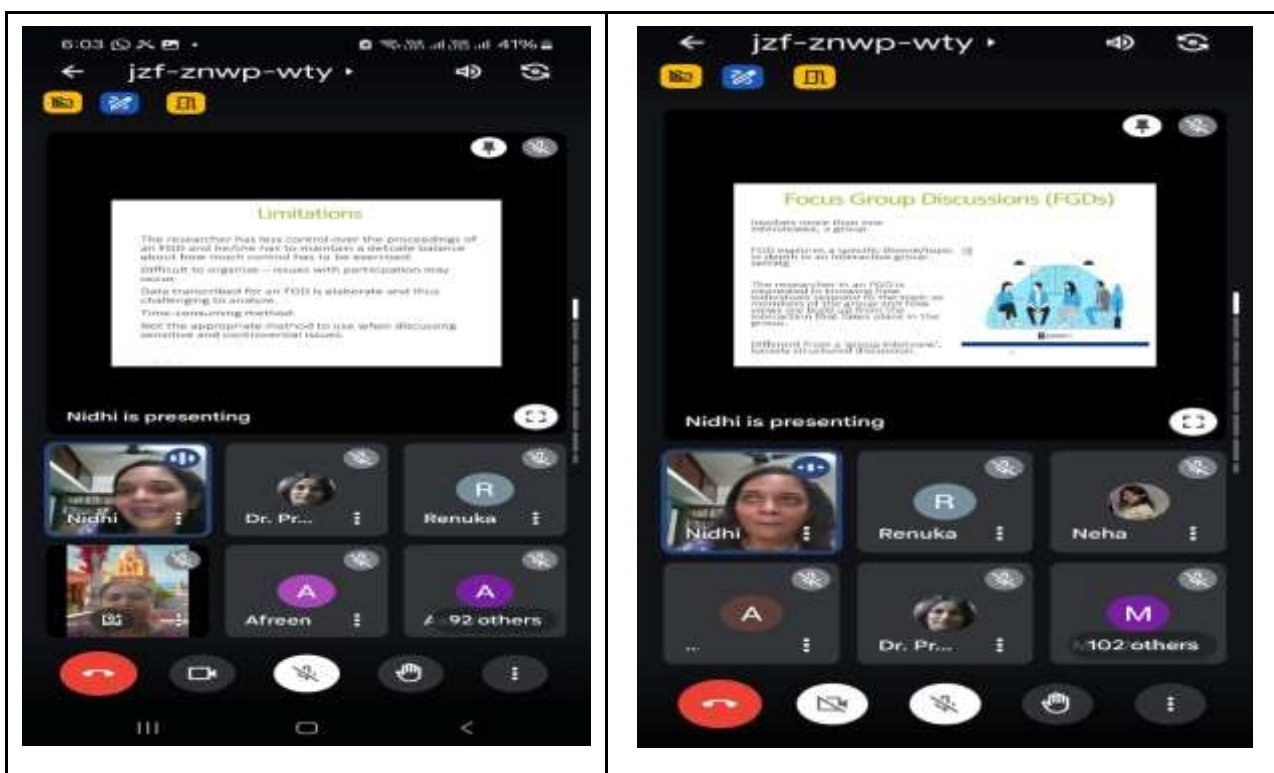

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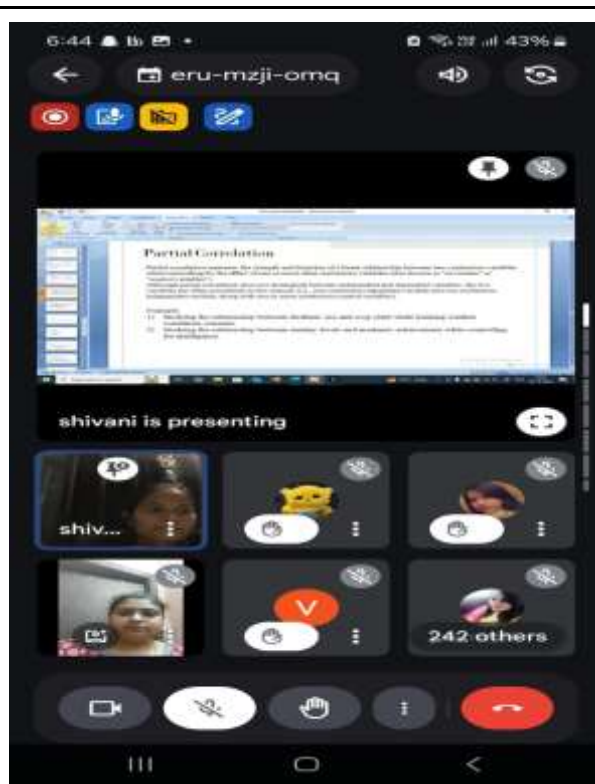
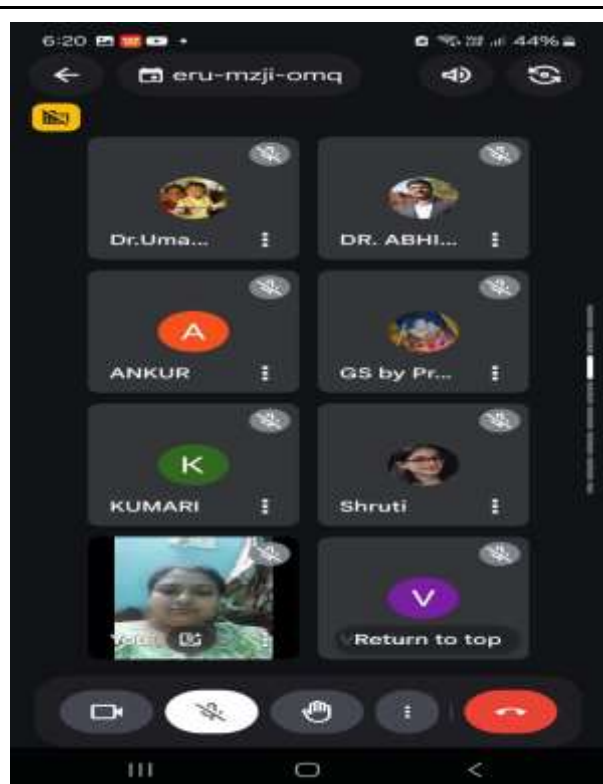
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7 - Days Online Lecture Series Cum Workshop on Working with SPSS

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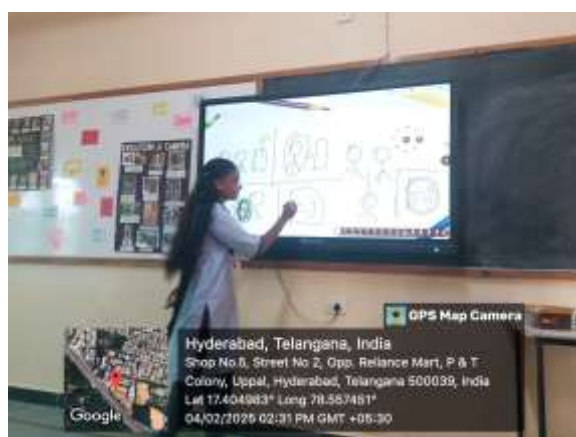
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Inter - Collegiate Competition – COMMERCE - SKETCH IT

The Department of Commerce, LFDC, in collaboration with RBI-Hyderabad, organized Financial Awareness Week from 20th to 28th February 2025.

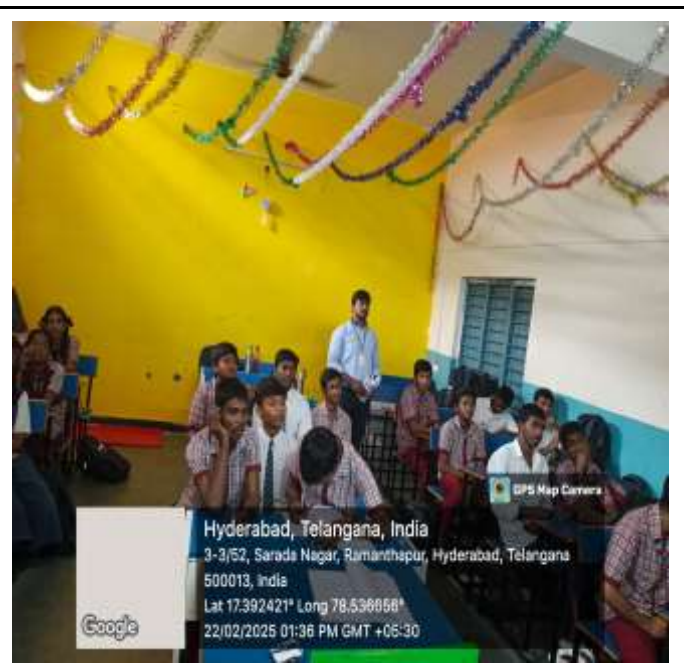

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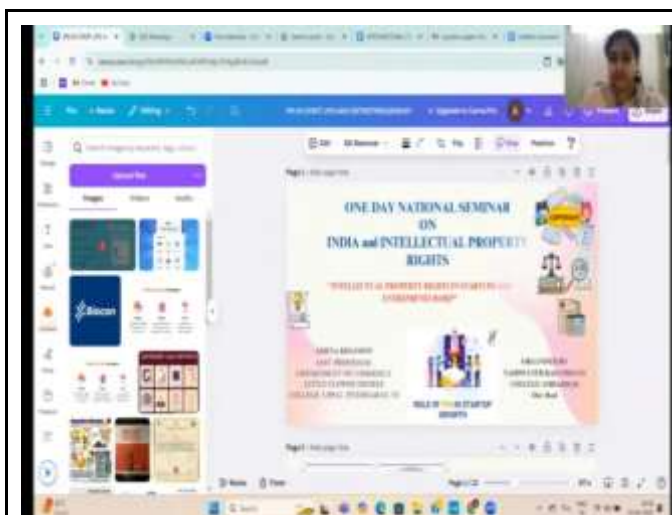

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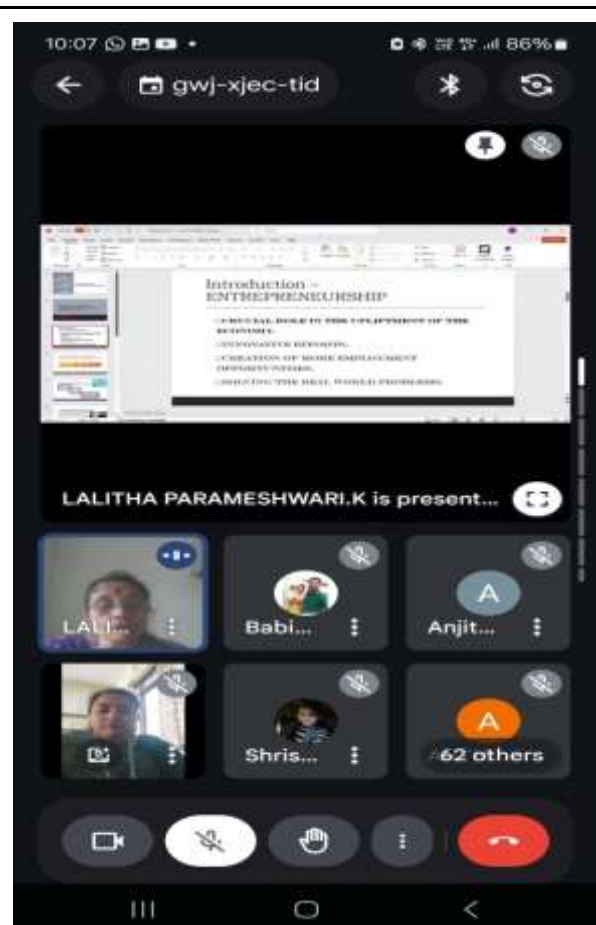
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ONLINE NATIONAL WEBINAR ON -A JOURNEY TOWARDS SUCCESSFUL ENTREPRENEURSHIP

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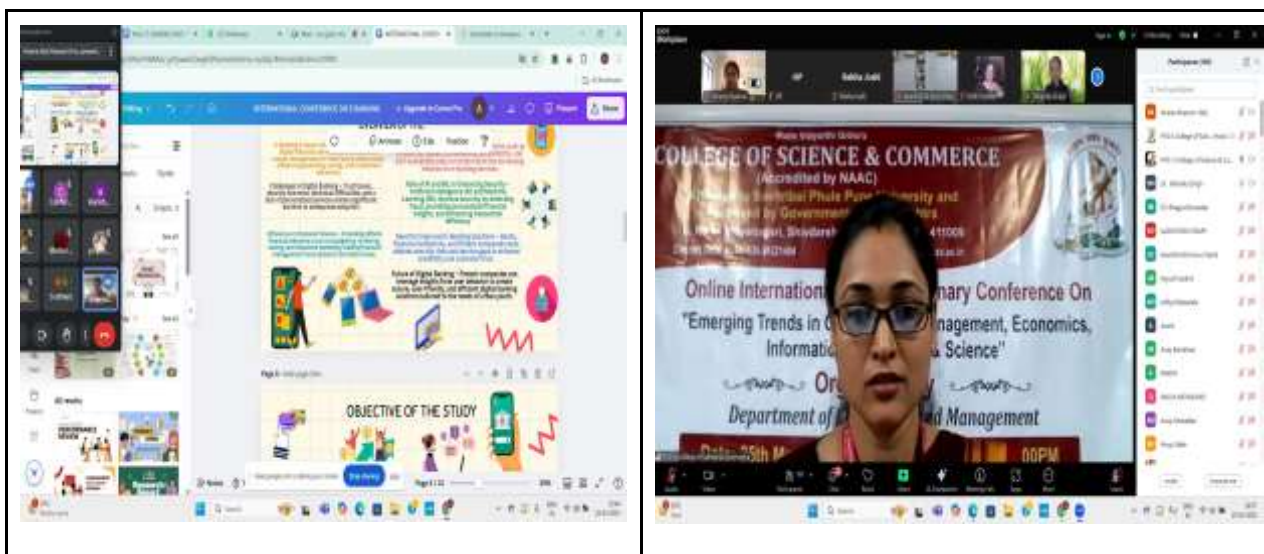
