### FIELD TRIP ON NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

National Youth Day is celebrated on the 12th of January every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda. The Vernacular Voices Club of Little Flower Degree and Pg College encouraged the students to take part in the seminar organised at Ramakrishna Math to gain knowledge about the significance and the values taught by Swami Vivekananda. The students, along with the language faculty, visited the Ramakrishna Math. The session began with the history of celebrating National Youth Day. In 1984, the Government of India declared this day as National Youth Day, and it has been celebrated every year since then. The guest of honour was TGK Murthy, an author who also worked for ISRO. He shared his experience of writing a book named "Swami Vivekananda: An Intuitive Scientist," in which he explained how Swami Vivekananda worked for the welfare and advancement of technology in India. The chief guest was Anil Bhardwaj, an Indian astrophysicist. He was involved in the working of Chandrayaan 3 and explained the struggles faced by individuals and how their collective efforts contributed to the success of the mission. He also delivered a presentation on how the rocket landed on the moon and discussed various aspects of it. Later, the math students performed a skit depicting the various stages of Swami Vivekananda's life, from his childhood to his emergence as a great individual, followed by musical performances of bhajans.
