

Short Report: Workshop on Cyber Security

The Department of Computer Science orchestrated a Cyber Security Workshop on February 17th, 2024, commencing at 10:00 am and concluding at 12:30 pm in the esteemed Heritage Hall, open to all academic streams.

Mr. Prashanth Ejjumala, expounded on various facets of cyber security. He elucidated the merits and demerits of social media usage, strategies to shield oneself from cyber threats, techniques for safeguarding personal data on computers and mobile devices, importance of maintaining robust password security etc.
