REPORT:

The students of all years of BBA visited India's biggest incubation center, the Telangana Hub located in the IIIT-Hyderabad campus, Gachibowli. It is popularly called T-Hub. The students were received by Mr. Shankar, a representative of T-Hub who showed them around the whole facility. Further Mr. Abhinav took to explaining things in much detail. He presented the actual policies of T-Hub. In contrast to the misconception that T-hub provides support to unestablished start-ups; it actually provides support to only fintech companies which have already established. T-hub still offers various opportunities to budding entrepreneurs through its various branches. For example, TSIC provides training to people aiming to become entrepreneurs. T-tribe is a community at T-Hub that connects people with various skills looking for an alliance to form for their startup. He also spoke about the functioning of start-ups in T-Hub. Approximately 160-170 start-ups have physical presence in T-Hub. They are to pay a minimal amount for the facilities provided inside T-Hub. He also explained about the legalities the start-ups have to go through. We had also learnt that T-Hub has connections with about 3000 start-ups. There was a reveal of the
