The valedictory was done with felicitation of both resource persons and then the national anthem. Participation certificates were issued to the participants for their active participation in the workshop.













PROJECTS ON PRODUCED BIOENZYME FROM CITRUS PEEL WASTE



Under graduate students of BTMC final year, for their semester 6 project, produced bioenzyme from citrus peel waste collected from a local juice centre. The production of Bio Enzyme with this method is not only cost effective but also contributes to the management of organic wastes by recycling them. The produced bioenzyme was used to treat leachate which is a toxic and viscous liquid which is the resultant of the continuous and prolonged discharge of unsegregated waste. The above project was undertaken in order to train students and to evoke consciousness about the current societal and environmental issues around them. Dr. J. Usha Rani, assistant professor microbiology is the supervisor. The leachate sample was collected from the Devendra Nagar waste treatment plant. The sample chosen specifically for the project is an intermediate leachate (i.e. the leachate that has formed over the span of 5-10 years).




